We are planning on inviting all the Maltese DAF Truck Owners / drivers and their families to join us for a short drive from Ta' Qali and back to Ta' Qali via our premises in Burmarrad.

In addition, at Ta' Qali we are making available a parking area for our participants to park their DAF trucks. Enclosed please find the map of the route.

Upon arrival again at Ta' Qali, the company will welcome the participants with some refreshments by our partners. The activity will be concluded by a presentation of gifts to participants at around 4:30 p.m.
